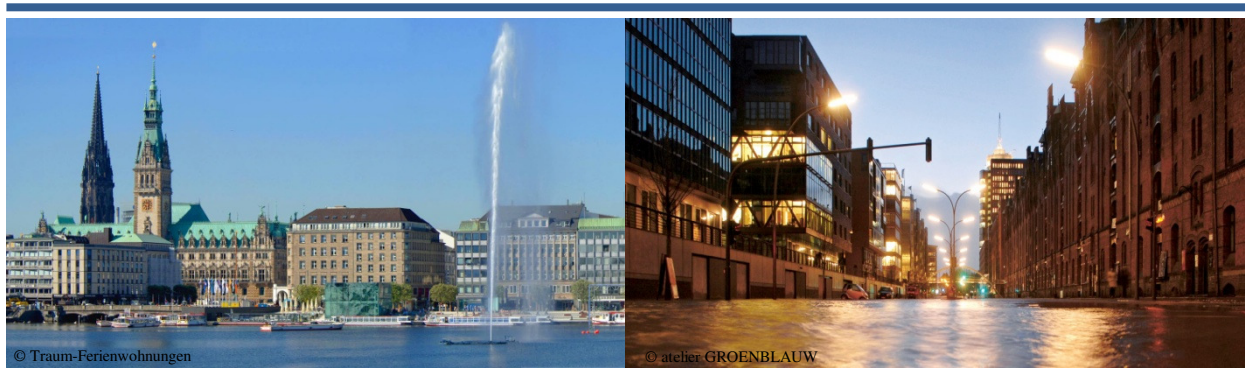
Dear Madam/Sir,
